Daily Operational Checklist

Before cleaning with your machine there are a few pre-operational checks that need to be done to confirm your machine is ready to be used.

- Check the condition of the main brush.
For maximum brush life and best performance, remove any string, banding, plastic wrap, or other debris wrapped around the brush and rotate the main brush end-to-end, after every 50 hours of operation.
- Check the main brush compartment right hand skirt for damage and wear.
- Check the side sweeping brush for damage and wear.
Remove any string, banding, plastic wrap, or other debris wrapped around the brush.
- Check the main brush compartment left hand skirt for damage and wear.
- Check the engine air filter indicator.
- Check the engine oil level.
- Confirm the cooling fan screen and radiator fins are clean.
- Check the hydraulic fluid level.
- Check for leaks and rubbing hoses or wires.
- Check the headlights, taillights and safety lights.
- Check the steering and brakes for proper operation.
- Raise the hopper, set the safety leg and check the hopper skirt & brush compartment skirts for wear or damage.
- Check the service records to determine maintenance requirements.
